



ALAN EADS

HEAD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH AND CAMP DIRECTOR

Coach Eads, all-time winningest coach for women's basketball at Missouri S&T, enters his 17th season at the helm of the university's program. He led the team to nine straight Great Lakes Valley Conference Tournament appearances from 2005-14, as well as three appearances in the NCAA Division II Tournament in the last eight seasons. Eads came to Missouri S&T after serving as an assistant coach at Southeast Missouri State University for eight seasons. He has also built an impressive resume as a head coach, leading Moberly Area Community College to a record of 199-37 over a span of eight years from 1986-94. Eads, who is originally from Trenton, Mo., earned his bachelor's degree in education in 1973 and his master's degree in education in 1982 from the University of Missouri-Columbia.



MIKE BROWN

ASSISTANT WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH

Brown spent the two seasons prior as an assistant coach at Kilgore Junior College in Kilgore, Texas. During his tenure at Kilgore he helped guide the Lady Rangers to a 37-25 record and an appearance in the Region XIV Tournament Championship game.

Prior to his time at Kilgore, Brown spent five seasons coaching at William Penn College. He was an assistant for two seasons before being promoted to head coach prior to the 2012-13 season. During his tenure as head coach he guided the Statesmen to a 42-47 mark. In his first season he led the team to a 19-10 record, 9-3 in the Midwest Collegiate Conference which was good for second place. It was the program's best ever finish in league play. He had eight players earn all-conference honors during his tenure and coached the MCC's Newcomer of the Year in 2013-14.

GIRLS' BASKETBALL CAMP

June 11-14, 2018 (9 a.m.-noon, Monday-Thursday) Grades 3-10

- Individuals - \$95
- Two or more per family (each) - \$85

Young players will learn the fundamentals and skills of the game of basketball as well as develop ideals in sportsmanship, leadership and citizenship. Campers will be divided into groups based on age and ability. An emphasis will be placed on the development of shooting, ball handling, rebounding, passing and defense skills. Time will be spent on footwork, pivots, balance and proper positioning. We will have 8 ft. goals for younger campers. Campers will have the opportunity to participate in free-throw, hot shot, speed dribbling, 3v3 and 1v1 contests. 5v5 games will also be a part of daily activities. Prizes will be awarded for all contest winners.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

All campers must provide their own basketball shoes and waterbottles. Basketballs will be provided for use during camp. Please make sure all personal property is properly marked by its owner. Missouri S&T Athletics/Women's Basketball is not responsible for the loss of personal property while at camp.

HEALTH DOCUMENTATION

Medical insurance is required for all camp participants. Insurance company and policy numbers must be recorded on Camper Registration form (see other side) or online (see right).

LOCATION AND FACILITIES

The Girls' Basketball Camp will be held in the Student Recreation Center, on the beautiful Missouri S&T campus. The facility is located on the corner of West 10th street and Highway 63/Bishop road in Rolla, Missouri.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

The Missouri S&T Girls' Basketball Camp will go from 9 a.m.-noon each day. So that the camp schedule can be maintained, it is very important that campers arrive by 8:45 a.m. each morning and be picked up promptly at noon. Campers should be dropped off and picked up at the Student Recreation Center.

ENROLLMENT AND FEES

A full payment for enrollment of \$95 per camper, or \$85 per camper for two or more per family, is required for all persons registering for the Girls' Basketball Camp with their completed Registration Form. Fill out one form for each camper being registered. Campers will be accepted until the start of camp as space permits, providing the staff to camper ratio will not be affected in a way that diminishes the quality of the camp. Campers will receive instruction and a Missouri S&T Girls' Basketball Camp T-shirt.
